Key Findings from the Report: Abandoned in their Neighborhoods: Youth Joblessness amidst the Flight of Industry and Opportunity produced by The University of Illinois at Chicago's Great Cities Institute:

- In Chicago:
 - > 85% of Black teens, 82% of Hispanic teens and 73% of White teens were jobless; and
 - ➤ 60% of Black young adults (20-24), 33% of Hispanic young adults (20-24) and 24% of White young adults (20-24) were jobless.
- In Illinois:
 - > 81% of Black teens, 72% of Hispanic teens and 65% of White teens were jobless; and
 - > 51% of Black young adults (20-24), 29% of Hispanic young adults (20-24) and 29% of White young adults (20-24) were jobless.
